

LaTeX Template:

To use this template, you will need access to a Unix/Linux computer with LaTeX installed. Whether or not you use the template, you remain responsible for insuring that your dissertation meets the formatting requirements of the Graduate School.

Download and unzip the separate template zip file (thesis_template.zip) posted on the template Web site. The template uses thesis.tex as a container of everything (chapters). Some of the names of chapters, such as "intro" etc., are presumably common among different fields, whereas "event_selection" may not be needed in most fields.

"mnthesis.cls" contains all the settings to make sure that the resulting .pdf file will meet the Graduate School requirements.

You will need to edit individual chapters in separate files. When you are ready, issue the following command on a Unix/Linux computer with LaTeX installed:

```
latex thesis.tex
```

```
latex thesis.tex (2nd time is needed for Latex to work out all the linking of references, etc.)
```

```
dvips thesis.dvi (to convert the dvi file that latex produces into a postscript file)
```

```
ps2pdf thesis.ps thesis.pdf (to convert the postscript file to a pdf file)
```

References, etc, may need to be handled differently in different fields.
